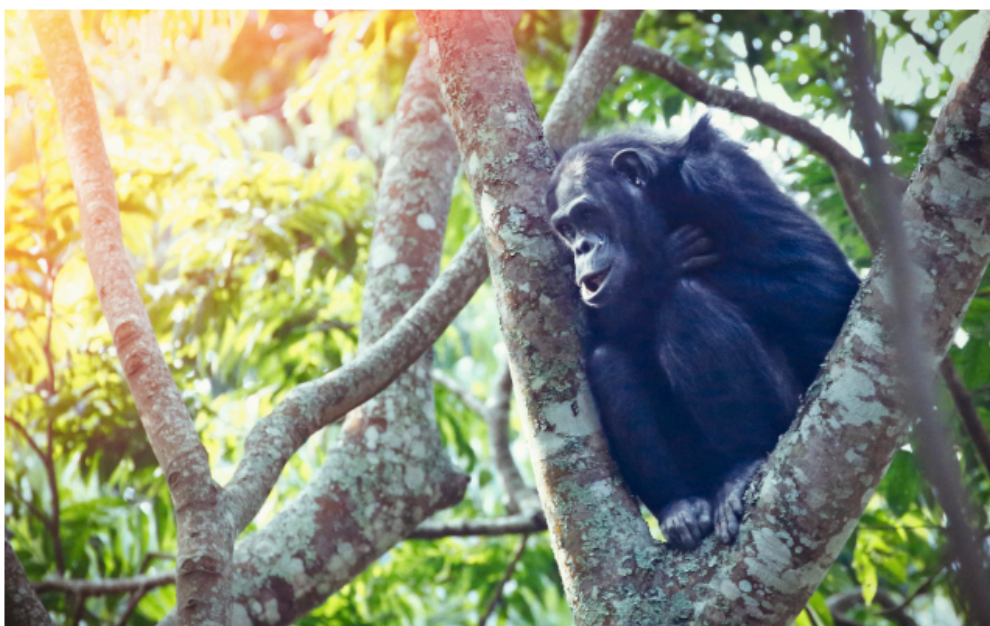

What we learned from the chimps of Dynasties – and where to see them in the wild

2. Greystoke Mahale, Tanzania

Richard Madden [visited this far-flung safari camp for Telegraph Travel](#), which is set beneath the forested slopes of the Mahala Mountains. He wrote: "Apart from the pristine beauty of the location, Greystoke's main attraction is the chance to see one of the largest populations of wild chimpanzees in the world, a community of more than 60 chimps that have been habituated to short spells of human contact.

"The occasions when the chimps came into the camp itself were always unforgettable as they climbed into the trees in front of the guest bandas and casually wandered through the main staff area. But the mood of the group could also change with bewildering speed, peaceful periods of grooming interrupted by a cacophony of pant-hoots, whimpers, barks and tantrum screams whenever one of the big males approached.
