Kenya: Olare Mara Kempinski Masai Mara: "Africa's Leading Luxury Tented Safari Camp 2018"

A fusion of luxury and classic safari elegance, Olare Mara Kempinski Masai Mara is nestled at the heart of its own private conservancy, and promises guests a stay full of 5-Star luxury with a classic under-canvas safari experience. Surrounded by the Masai Mara plains, this is where you can discover the theatre of the African wilderness. Featuring twelve tents, a central lounge and dining area, a tented bar set deep within a forested glade, and a shaded swimming pool, the Olare Mara Kempinski Masai Mara delivers a fusion of untamed wilderness and sophisticated elegance. Your stay can include campfire cocktails, sundowners on the plains, game drives, guided walks, balloon safaris, horse-riding and a colourful range of Masai cultural interaction.

Tanzania: Greystoke Mahale: "Africa's Leading Safari Lodge 2018"

This is Tanzania's acclaimed jungle-chic lodge located on the shores of Lake Tanganyika, under the green-covered Mahale Mountains of Western Tanzania. There are 6 thatched "bandas" here, all constructed in a rustic style with wood from retired fishing dhows; which include en-suite bathrooms, and an upstairs lookout deck with uninterrupted views of the lake and thick green mountain forests. There's also a large central communal dining area, library, and open lounge to relax around throughout the day and into the evening. For wildlife enthusiasts, one of Greystoke Mahale's classic experiences is a guided journey into the forests to observe the region's wild chimpanzees.

Zanzibar: Essque Zalu Zanzibar: "Zanzibar's Leading Hotel 2018" and "Tanzania's Leading Boutique Hotel 2018"

Essque Zalu Zanzibar is beautifully located on the far northern coast of Zanzibar, and is one of the Spice Island's more luxurious resorts. Guests can choose from 40 suites, or 8 expansive villas, all with picturesque views over the lush tropical garden or the turquoise blue ocean, and all featuring luxurious-styled interiors adorned with Zanzibari crafts and locally sourced natural materials, and housed under a traditional pitched makuti roof. There's an outdoor gym here, lots of watersports (including an off-site diving centre affiliated with the hotel), fully equipped kids club, beautiful infinity pool, and the Essque Zalu Zanzibar spa, which provides a unique, signature wellness journey called The Maasai Ritual. As the evening approaches, you can step onto the deck of a traditional dhow, sip a sundowner and cruise into the African sunset, before returning to a choice of three restaurants, a scrumptious café, and two well-stocked bars
